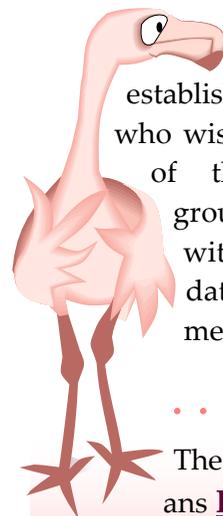

- ‡ Purchased special eyeglasses for “Sandy” whose disability is likely to lead to blindness.
- ‡ Helped “Anna,” who was paralyzed in a car accident, regain some independence by paying for hand controls for her vehicle.
- ‡ Purchased a prosthetic leg for “Meg” with a rare form of bone cancer.
- ‡ Helped “Susan” who had ovarian cancer, stay in her home by helping her with her tax and insurance payments.
- ‡ Assisted “Cindy” with living expenses to keep her in her own home while she battled breast cancer.
- ‡ Contributed to the purchase of groceries and items for daily living for “Linda” who lives with debilitating lupus.



Friends of the Flock...

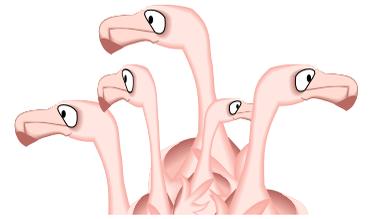
